



The mission of the Three Sisters Scholarship Foundation is to provide incentive for aspiring students to complete their college career and to achieve beyond. We are providing scholarships to Black high school seniors who will attend a four-year college or university.

\$6000 will be awarded to two senior women and one senior man from Evanston Township High School who have demonstrated academic excellence or improvement, involvement in school activities and/or team sports, and an interest in community service. \$3000 will be awarded at the start of the first year; an additional \$3000 will be awarded at the beginning of the third year.

This year you have the option of filling out the application and sending it via snail mail to the address given on the next page, or completing the PDF form and emailing the application to the web address on the next page. Transcripts can be mailed separately.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen by the TSSF Board of Directors and announced in June, at the Unity Celebration. Winners will receive funds upon proof of enrollment.
